Purpose of the Graduate Follow-up Survey

Each year, Holyoke Community College (HCC) gathers information on our recent graduates. A graduate follow-up survey was distributed to all graduates from the current calendar year. The purpose of the graduate follow-up survey is two fold. First, students were asked to self-report on their employment and educational status. Second, it was an attempt to learn something about how HCC students evaluate the college and the experience(s) the college affords. Was their experience satisfying? Did it help them move toward their goals?

A survey for the class of 2021 was distributed to 765 graduates and 16% of these graduates responded to the survey. The graduate follow-up survey is administered 3-6 months after graduation. Survey data are based on graduates within a calendar year. Federal (IPEDS) and State (HEIRS) reports are based on fiscal year. As a result figures here may differ from those reported elsewhere.

³106 is the actual number of graduates who responded to the employment question. As Table 1 shows, 72% of those 106 graduates are employed. 34% are employed in a related field. Some graduates had multiple credentials and their employment & enrollment data were counted in multiple degree titles. Some graduates were from programs that had only one graduate and those data and subtotal rows were excluded or amended due to guarantee of data confidentiality. However, these graduates were included in the Grand Total (n=109) row.
