HCC offering scholarships

More than \$200,000 in scholarship money is available for new, current and transferring Holyoke Community College students for the 2019-2020 academic year. The application deadline is March 20.

Students must be currently enrolled at the college or have been accepted for the upcoming academic year to be eligible for scholarships, which are awarded through its nonprofit fundraising corporation, the Holyoke

Community College Foundation, a 501(c)(3).

"Scholarships through the HCC Foundation support and recognize the accomplishments of students pursuing any field of study, from various backgrounds, across all the communities we serve," said Amanda Sbriscia, vice president of institutional advancement and the foundation's executive director. "Thanks to our donors, HCC students have the chance to benefit from funding that will

For the 2018-2019 academic year, the foundation awarded 140 different scholarships to 223 students.
