The Performance Project is pleased to announce internship, work study and community engagement opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students. We are now based in downtown Holyoke, a five minute walk from the bus station.

The Performance Project is an arts, social justice, and intergenerational mentoring program for youth, age 14-22. Through performance and visual art, we build a supportive community for youth.

First Generation members create and perform original, multi-lingual physical theater based on their life experiences and personal narratives. This year we'll be continuing developing a new work, "*Stand Tall, Mi Gente!*" We also hold theater residencies in public schools.

In our visual arts programs we do residencies and community projects with youth in the custody of the Department of Youth Services (DYS).
