### Advising Notes for the Holyoke CC-to-Westfield SU MassTransfer Pathway in Criminal Justice

1. Students transferring to Westfield must complete the 34-credit MassTransfer Block to receive MassTransfer/Pathways benefits.

2. A cumulative average of 2.50 is required for admission to the WSU Criminal Justice major. Qualified students are guaranteed admission to the major for their entrance term of choice as long as space remains available.

3. Students who apply for fall semester WSU admission, but must take summer term courses to complete the associate degree, will be admitted after submitting to the WSU admission office the list of summer term courses for which they have registered. Students who apply for spring semester WSU admission, but must take winter session courses to complete the associate degree, will be admitted after submitting to the WSU admission office the list of winter session courses for which they have registered.

4. A maximum of 18 HCC CRJ credits will transfer into the WSU Criminal Justice major; and, a minimum of 21 credits of Criminal Justice major requirements must be completed at Westfield. Consequently, WSU strongly recommends that HCC students select
