The Awards

723 Total Awards

- 636 Associate Degrees Awarded (221 AA degrees, 409 AS Degrees, 6 AAS Degrees), 67 *Different Programs*
- 87 Certificates Awarded, 15 *Different Certificates*

Gender

- 37% Male (n=256)
- 63% Female (n=429)
