Once at WSU, students will see a block called Additional University Requirements that lists Integrated Experience and Exploring Writing in the Major. These courses will be covered by required courses in the major, once approved by Governance: Integrated Experience → NURS 0396 Nursing Capstone and Clinical Internship Exploring Writing in the Major → NURS 0305 Nursing Research or NURS 0309 Community Health Nursing

**MassTransfer Block course codes and credit requirements are as follows:**

**A** = English Composition > 6 credits/ 2 courses

**B** = Behavioral & Social Sciences > 9 credits/ 3 courses

**C** = Humanities & Fine Arts > 9 credits/ 3 courses

**D** = Mathematics > 3 credits/ 1 course

**E** = Natural & Physical Sciences > 7 credits/ 2 courses, including one 4-credit lab course
