Important Notes:			
Areas listed under University Requirements are determined by the major, which means the credits won't be set until they are. These courses are not part of WISE.			
If MAT 142 is taken at HCC, that will cover the MATH 0108 requirement and fulfill the MassTransfer Block, which will fulfill WISE.			
If a student does not complete the MassTransfer Block and transfers more than 60 credits, they will need to fulfill the following areas of WISE:			
Rhetoric and Inquiry (3-4 credits) - Covered by English Comp I Inquiry into Patterns, Data, and Reasoning (3 credits) - Covered by Statistics Inquiry into the Natural World (4 credits) - Covered by all Biology Labs Civic Learning or Power and Perspectives - Will need to be selected after consultation with advisor			
All bachelor's degrees require a minimum of 120 credits, so student's may need to take elective courses to fulfill that requirement.

The table below defines the requirements the students must take at the Associate's level to receive the MassTransfer Block and their associated benefits (32-33 credits)

MassTransfer Block course codes and credit requirements are as follows:

A = English Composition > 6 credits/ 2 courses

B = Behavioral & Social Sciences > 9 credits/ 3 courses

C = Humanities & Fine Arts > 9 credits/ 3 courses

D = Mathematics > 3 credits/ 1 course

E = Natural & Physical Sciences > 7 credits/ 2 courses, including one 4-credit lab course
